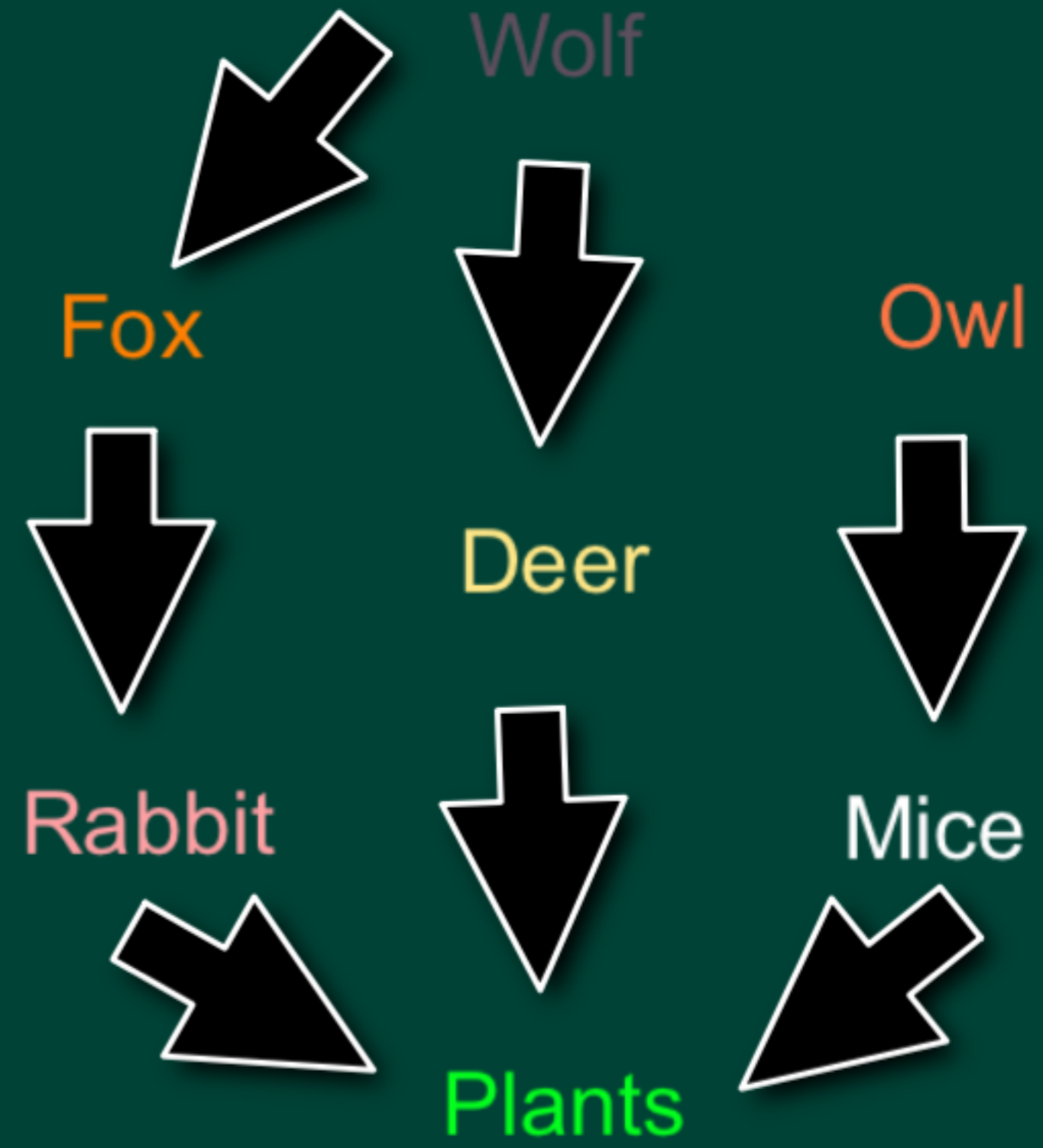
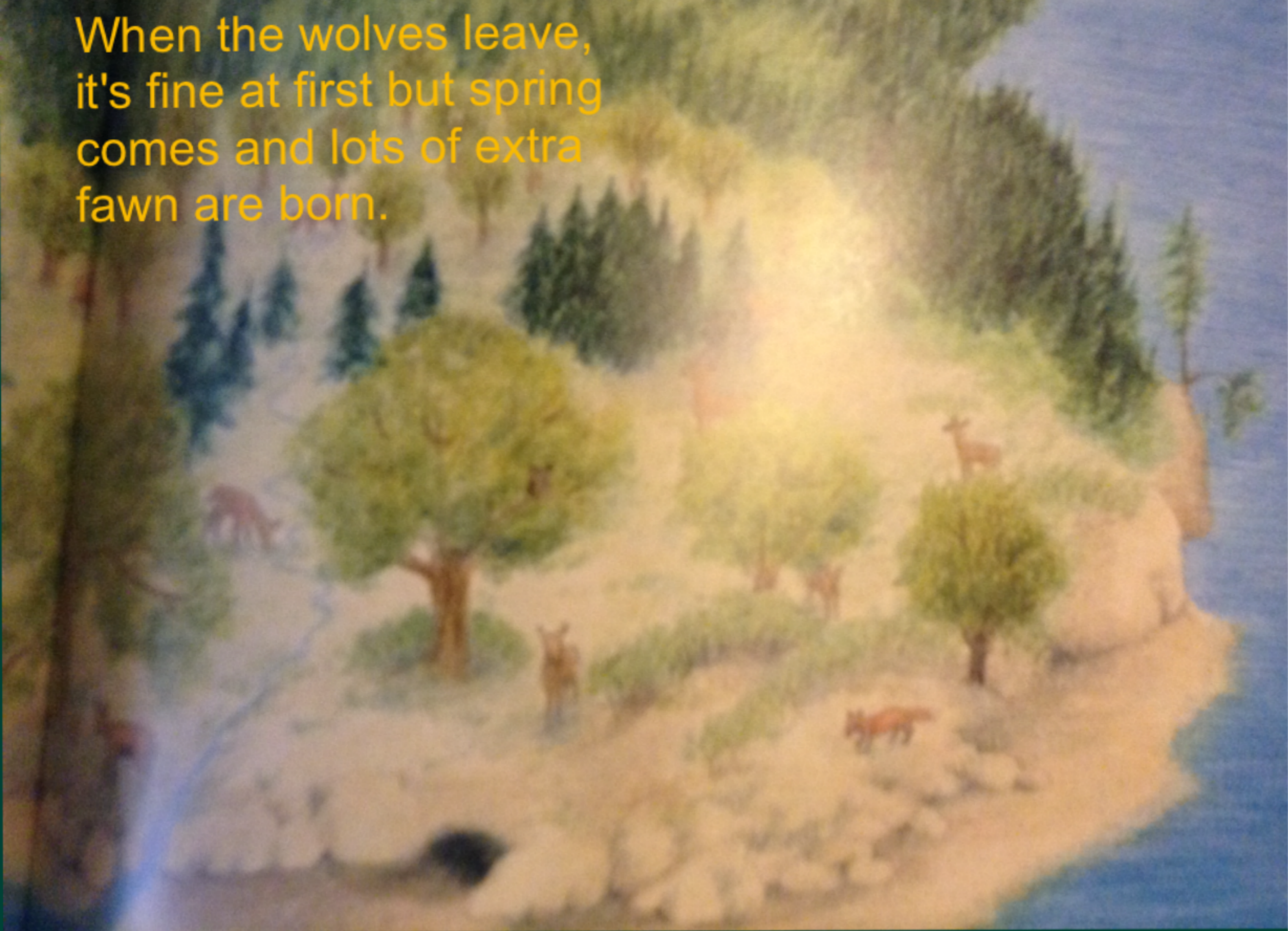


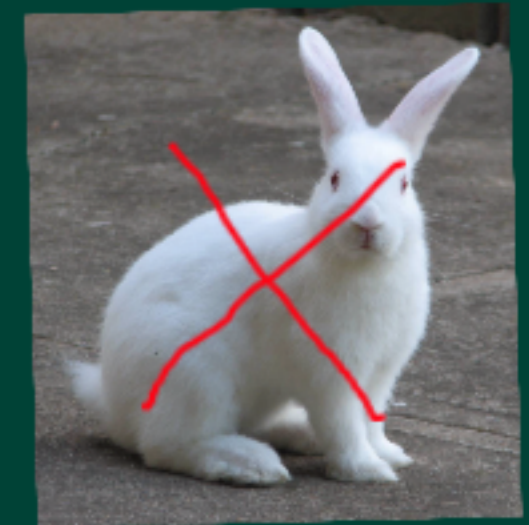
What happens when the wolves leave wolf island.

fawn are born.



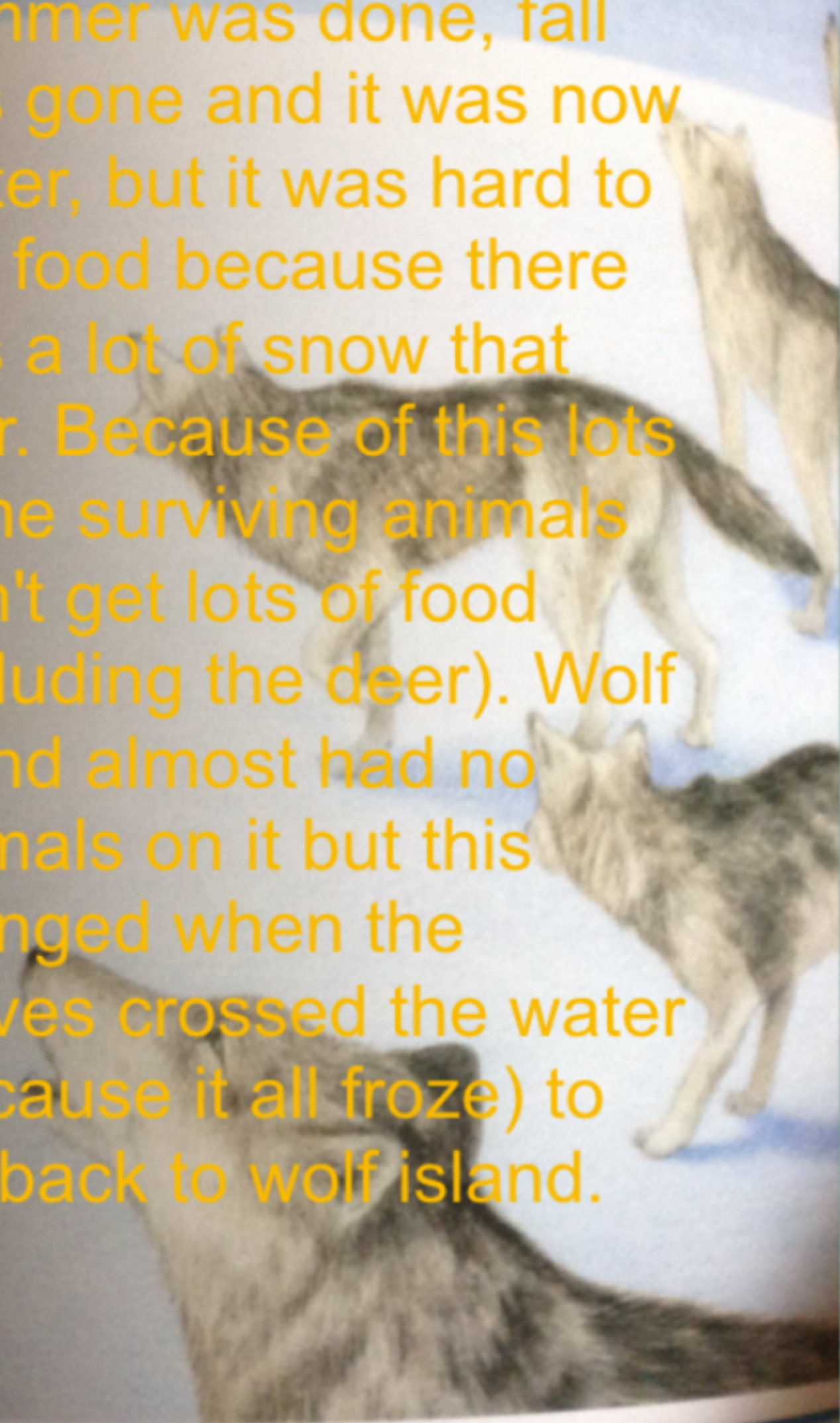
Because there was so many deer they ate more plants so there was not enough for the rabbits and mice. Because of this lots of mice and rabbits died.



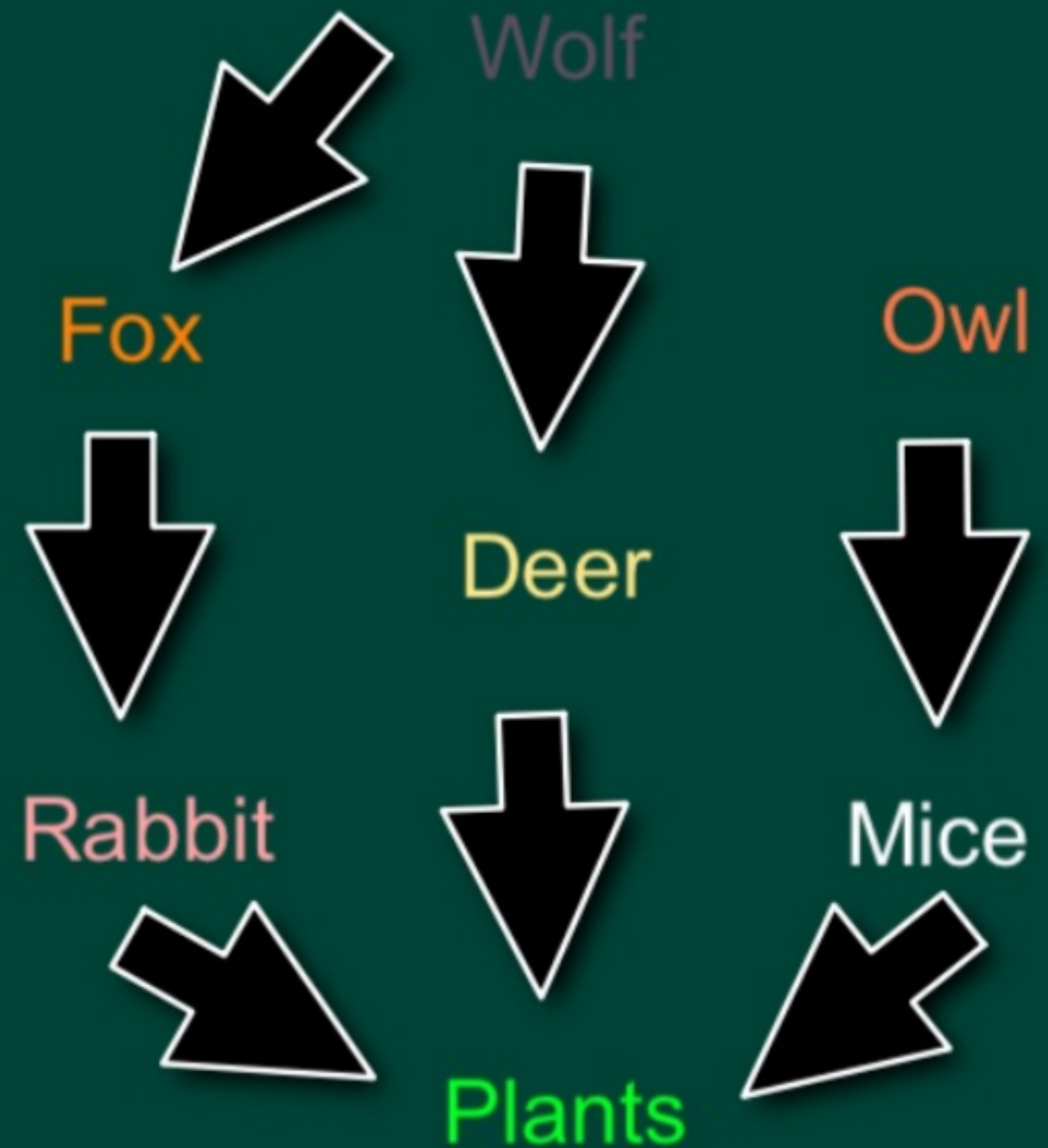
Because there were less rabbits and mice to eat the foxes and owls started going hungry. If the wolves don't come back in time the whole island will be deserted.
